We have been especially glad during the challenging year of 2020 to be able to support Darwin Barker Library. This support, summarized below, depends on the generous donations of community members. We also applaud the amazing work of library director, Sara Hart, and all of the library staff members for their willingness to quickly adapt to changing circumstances and their commitment to continued quality services and programming for patrons. In 2020, we had 181 members, with 15 at the Life membership level. We raised \$8775 through memberships and gifts, which has supported the library patrons and staff in many ways as listed below.

Covid-19 related expenses:
