Curator's Report

Acquisition

- Barker museum to receive artifacts from the Barker Hose Co., as well as archives from the Opera House.
- On May 9th we received a seed box from the Risley Co, which makes this one of our earliest items from the seed packet industry.

Outreach

- Lafayette marker update: Funded by Pomroy, the sign that will commemorate Lafayette's visit to Fredonia in 1825 will be placed on the Barker's grounds facing the Commons. Ceremony to take place June 4th.
- Barker's request to join the Underground Railroad Consortium membership committee has been reviewed and accepted.
 - The UGRR Consortium manages a heritage trail along the Harriet Tubman corridor made up of museums and historic buildings associated with the underground railroad. The Barker museum qualifies due to our association with the Pettit family and the Sketches of the Underground Railroad book written and published in Fredonia. Membership allows access to cooperative marketing, programming, and inclusion on the organization's member maps and heritage trail.
- Microfilm update: All microfilm newspapers are now digitized on Fultonhistory.com and original copies have been returned to the museum's collection. Some lingering issues remain with file name

standardization and possible solutions are being explored with the site's manager. In addition, both microfilm readers have been repaired and are operational.

- Grape Belt Archive update: Over 400 items from the GBA have now been cataloged in preparation for their inclusion on the Omeka online database later this year.
